- Trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each category.
- The tournament will be formed into groups with the winner of each group proceeding to the next round, and so on, to the finals
- Competitors must report to the registration desk on arrival
- Only suitable sportswear and non-marking footwear is permitted.
- All competitors must wear shorts/skirts during games. No tracksuit bottoms acceptable
- All late arrivals will be excluded from the event – all entry fees are non-refundable
- There will no substitution of players permitted. There will be NO changes on the day.
- 'Retirement' from a round/group will deem all of those player's previous game 'null & void'
- The Referee's decision will be final

## TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS

- Places in the tournament will be limited and will be allocated on a 'first come, first serve' basis. NO late entries will be accepted. (So if your partner has not sent in their form, you could forfeit your place as well!)**
- This tournament is STRICTLY for players that have not been selected for any of the current Sussex County Squads
- Players must either live in or attend a school/club in the Districts of Wealden, Rother, Hastings, Lewes, Brighton and Eastbourne
- (a) Competitors must be born on or after: in the U11's- 1st January 2001, U13's-1999, U15's 1997 & in the U17's-1995.  
(b) Competitors may only play in one age group.
- Feather shuttlecocks will be used throughout.
- The 'rally-points scoring system' will be used.
- The tournament will be formed into groups with the winner of each group proceeding to the next round, and so on, to the finals
- Group Winners will be determined by total number of points gained. In the event of a 'tie', points against, then the games against the other contender.
- Group winners and runners-up will proceed through to the knockout stages.
- Trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each discipline and age group.
- The tournament will be formed into groups with the winner of each group proceeding to the next round, and so on, to the finals
- A 'knock-out PLATE' competition may be run for those players not coming 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in their group, according to timings
- Competitors must report to the registration desk on arrival
- Competitors must arrive at least 15 minutes before their scheduled start time.
- No competitor is to leave the hall without first informing the organisers.
- Only suitable sportswear and non-marking footwear is permitted.
- All competitors must wear shorts/skirts during games. No tracksuit bottoms acceptable.
- All late arrivals will be excluded from the event – all entry fees are non-refundable
- There will no substitution of players permitted and there will be NO changes on the day.
- 'Retirement' from a round/group will deem all of those player's previous game 'null & void'
- The tournament secretary will arrange playing times as accurately as possible, but these will depend upon play and may be delayed or overrun  
NB: Format may vary on the day, at the discretion of the Competitions Committee and Referee.
- ESJBA cannot accept liability for injury or loss of personal belongings/equipment, however caused.
- The tournament Committee reserve the right to refuse entry and The Referee's decision on decisions concerning play will be final.
