1. Entry to the tournament is strictly for non-county players only (county players are defined as players who are members of a county training squad). Additionally, players who are not members of a county squad, but who are graded by BADMINTON England may not enter. Ex-county players who have been out of the county system for at least one season prior to the tournament may be allowed to enter after appraisal by the TWBL Junior Committee.
2. The tournament committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason and to alter or modify the programme in any way it sees fit.
3. Cheques/ postal orders should be made payable to **Tunbridge Wells Badminton League** or **TWBL** and sent with a completed entry form to the tournament secretary. Please include a stamped addressed envelope or a current email address with the entry.
4. Competitor's age groups - under 16 - born on or after 01/01/96, under 18 – born on or after 01/01/94.
5. Competitors may enter one age group only (playing in an additional age group is subject to the Referee's discretion)..
6. The event will be run in pools, the winner of a pool is the player who has won the most games, semi finals and finals will be played according to the number of pools.
7. All entries will be acknowledged and will indicate a start time via a SAE or email, please make enquiries if not received by 28<sup>th</sup> March 2012.
8. Recognised sports clothing must be worn. Trainers with non-marking soles are essential.
9. Competitors must report to the referee on arrival at least 10 minutes before playing time. Players who do not report on time or who cannot be found during the tournament are liable to be disqualified.
10. Spectators are welcome, but courtesy to all players and tournament officials is expected at all times.
11. Knocking-up is allowed only before the first game unless agreed by a tournament official.
12. The decision of the organising committee in all matters is final.
